- Massification of higher education:
 - Diverse student populations
 - Underprepared
 - First generation
 - Socio-economic challenges
- Response:
 - Student success/support initiatives
- Teaching Development Grant (TDG)
- Road to Success Programme (RSP)
- Collaboration with Institutional Research Unit



SUCCESS TUTORING

- Initial premise:
 - Ensure requisite capacity to provide holistic support to all students
 - Allow for peer-on-peer engagement
- RSP Core Team realised value of:
 - Student voice
 - Student experience
- Now plays an integral role in RSP:
 - Conceptualisation, development, implementation, and improvement



SUCCESS TUTORING

- Recruitment and attributes
 - Application and interview process
 - What do we look for?
- Training
 - Two day training
 - Day 1: RSP in-house training
 - Day 2: Student in Distress training
 - Objectives



SUCCESS TUTORING

- Growth and development
 - Regular Core Team engagement
 - Developmental workshops
 - Team building
- Evaluation and contribution
 - Tutor reflections
 - RSP symposia
- RSP has collected student engagement data since 2015



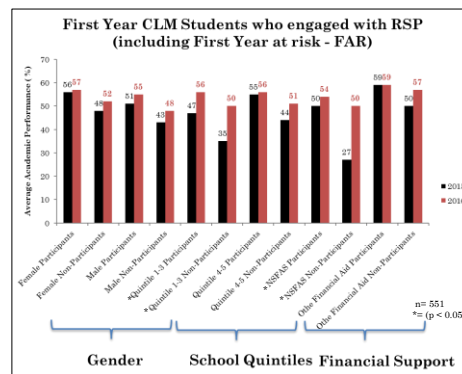
BIOGRAPHIC QUESTIONNAIRE

- Comprehensive school and student background questionnaire
- Understand how students' background affects their success at university
 - Home background
 - Finances, language, location, background of family members, etc.
 - School background
 - Language, availability and use of facilities, transportation, etc.



RSP DATA

- RSP attendance data
 - Student numbers of those who attended activities
 - Those who signed up but never attended used as control (non-participants)
- Biographic questionnaire / university student data
 - Student number linked to ascertain:
 - Gender
 - School quintile
 - Financial support
 - Student marks



CONCLUSIONS

- Continue efforts of linking data, to explore other variables of interest
- Recruit appropriate candidates
 - Senior students
 - Diverse academic and personal backgrounds
- Remuneration
- Cohort size
- Accommodate the student voice
- Benefits to tutors
