Service workshops by numbers: 2022



- 2022 13 service workshops (2 in person, 11 online)
- 18 Institutions attended
- 307 people attended
- Average attendance 26 people per workshop
- Average workshops attended
 - Partners: 8 workshops
 - Participants and Associates: 5


