


## Architects of Separate Development and Apartheid envisioned






## **Enrolments - By Population Group**






## Enrolments - By Gender




## **Enrolment by Quintiles**






Establish a more student-centred culture in South Africa's higher education system to improve student completion rates and reduce race and gender equity differences.

## **National Retention Rate**




Undergraduates of 3-year diploma, 3-year degree and 4-year degree programmes


4-year degree



### Siyaphumelela Retention Rate: **First Time Entering Students**



## National & Siyaphumelela Success Rates


Average of UG 3-year diploma, 3-year degree and 4-year degree programmes






## **Throughput Rates - 2017 Cohort**

#### Undergraduates of 3-year diploma, 3-year degree and 4-year degree programmes













