Dismal community college completion rates

✓ US workforce unprepared for the global economy



20 years ago...

35% working age adults had post-high school credential

> Lumina Goal: 60% by 2026

Obama Goal: 60% by 2020

Today: 53.7% = Nearly 20%pt. gain

- ✓ Quest for Equity our North Star




Role of Philanthropy

Successive terms

✓ Goal: Access and Success




Early Strategy: "Fix" Developmental (Remedial) Education

"Leakage points" especially at the start

- e.g., only 1 in 6 students referred to remedial math completed a credit-level course within 3 years
- Data/research showed most students could succeed at college level with supplemental support
- A Ha Moment: institutional policies and practices were creating barriers to student success




Three Year Graduation Rates at Sinclair College
